Tax claimed by The Oxford Oratory

- The Oxford Oratory will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- The Oxford Oratory will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you gave after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay to The Oxford Oratory an additional 3p on every £1 you gave between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for The Oxford Oratory does not affect your personal tax position.
- If you pay Income Tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
